Engine Compartment Heater Blower

Concern: Engine compartment heater blower, spare part information.

The engine compartment heater blower, part number, 964 624 328 00, for Information:

the above-mentioned vehicle types is no longer available as a replacement part. If a replacement part is required use, part number, 993 624 328 01.

The spacer bushings for the new heater blower are approximately. **6.0 mm** longer

than the former version.

For the first time installation of the new heater blower in vehicle types 911 Carrera 2/4 (964), the

spacer bushings must be shortened.

Procedure: - Mount new heater blower upside down in shop vise.

Caution: Secure heater blower lightly; the housing is made of plastic.

- Mark the spacer bushings to the required length of 29.0 ± 0.5 mm. Compare with the old blower housing bushing lengths.

- Using an appropriate tool, cut both spacer bushings at the markings. Counterhold the spacer with suit-

able pliers.

Caution: Use proper eye protection if working with an air saw. Follow the saw tool safety

procedures as recommended by the manufacturer.

- Check spacer bushings for straight cut; correct with a file if necessary. Chamfer all sharp edges.

- Install the new heater blower motor.
